The West Texas Association for Infant Mental Health (WTAIMH) is bringing Circle of Security® training to Lubbock on May 11-14. They are just introducing a four day, parent training facilitator workshop. It will begin on Monday, May 10th and go through Thursday, May 13th. When Charles Zeanah, MD, presented here in 2008, he said that the Circle of Security® training was the best training they had at their program at Tulane. The training in Lubbock will include:

- Four days of training
- COS Parenting DVD
- COS Training Manual
- Parent Handouts
- License to teach COS Parenting

From their website: “The Circle of Security® integrates over fifty years of early childhood attachment research into a video-based intervention to strengthen parents’ ability to observe and improve their caregiving capacity. Attachment theory, through the Circle of Security®, offers clear individualized, pathway for providing a secure relationship between parent and child.”

Registration will be on their website. The charge is \$800 per person which will pay for the training, DVD, license to use the DVD, facilitator’s manual, and parent manual. Kent Hoffman said that after our training the cost will be \$900 but as they had agreed to \$800 it would stand for the Lubbock training.
